8 Easy Steps for Recruiting Online

Make the Title Work for You

• Catchy, Fun, Interesting

Keep it Brief

One Opportunity, 100 words

Word it Simply and Make it Easy to Understand

No Jargon, no Acronyms

Make an Impact

Include a Strong Call to Action



8 Easy Steps for Recruiting Online

Provide Direction and Support

• Time Commitment, Training, Restrictions

Make it Visually Appealing

Include Pictures, Graphics. Make use of White Space.

Remember to Edit

Grammar, Spelling

View your Listing as a Volunteer

Use a Critical Eye.



Best Practices for VolunteerMatch

Title Stands Out

Call to Action

Make Good Use of First Sentence

Visible to prospective volunteers

Brainstorm and Use Keywords

What kinds of volunteers do you want to find you?

Keep Connections on Volunteer Match

Information is only useful if volunteers click 'I Want to Help!'




